

THE PYTHAGOREAN SYSTEM

Once you've learned how to reduce, you now know what it takes to break down the numbers of your full birth date. But in Numerology we also need to know how to break down the numbers in names. To do this, we must travel back 2,500 years and use Pythagoras' system for assigning a number to each letter of the alphabet.

The chart is shown below.

PYTHAGOREAN NUMBER SYSTEM

1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9
A	B	C	D	E	F	G	H	I
J	K	L	M	N	O	P	Q	R
S	T	U	V	W	X	Y	Z	

EXCEPTION:

If Y is next to a consonant (on both sides), it is considered a vowel.

If Y is next to a vowel (on either side), it is considered a consonant.

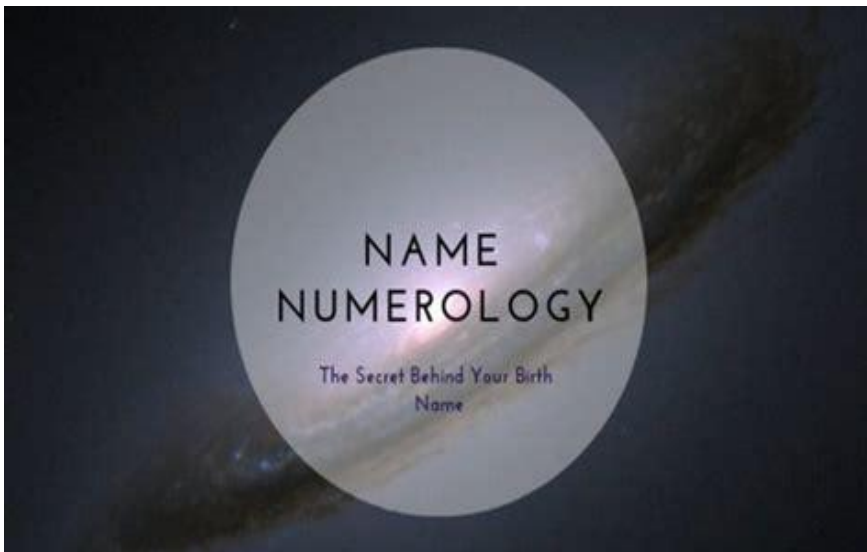
Example:

Joyce: The Y is a consonant because it is next to the vowel O.

Gwyneth: The Y is a vowel because it is between the two consonants W and N.
